

CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND (CRF) INSIGHTS

PandemicOversight.gov now has CRF data through June 30, 2021.

It's the only place to get detailed data on how this money was spent.

What is the CRF?

The CARES ACT made **\$150 billion** available to state & local governments, Tribal governments, and U.S. territories to help cover expenses incurred from the pandemic.



Funds can only be used for expenses incurred between March 1, 2020 and December 31, 2021.
